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Winemaker's Notes

Deep crimson in colour with generous aromas of boysenberry, blood plums, tar, coffee and vanilla.

A full bodied wine with a soft round flourish of fruit. The aromas are mirrored by the flavours on the palate that also have dark chocolate undertones. The tannins are supple, smooth and generous, just like the characters of the region.

Vintage Information

Warm and dry conditions prevailed for most of the 2012/13 growing season. Our Barossa grape farmers, using their years of experience, were able to manage their vineyards to produce small yields of highly flavoured grapes, reflected in this 2013 vintage Shiraz.
